## BISHOP JOHN BRADOSKY



Bishop John Bradosky was elected as bishop of the NALC in August. Prior to that, he served as the NALC's General Secretary. He has served as an ordained pastor for 32 years. His ministry in congregations includes experiences in urban, suburban and multicultural settings with multiple campus environments. He has served on Synod Council and Churchwide divisions and initiatives including: Stewardship, Outreach, Evangelism and Transformational Leadership initiative.

He provided leadership for the Churchwide Call to Discipleship, writing articles, Bible studies, creating conferences, addressing Synod Assemblies and providing training for Disciple Mentors.

He has also spent time working with missionaries in Mexico, Central America, Tanzania, Uganda and recently in Ethiopia. This opportunity has assisted him in developing a global perspective of the missional strength of the Church available to us through the experience of those where the Church is growing at its fastest rate.

He has also served as President of Lutheran Bible Institute of California and as adjunct faculty there. For nine years he was on the board, chair and member of the Ethics Committee of Graceworks Lutheran Services.

Bishop Bradosky and his wife, Kristi, live in Centerville, Ohio.
